



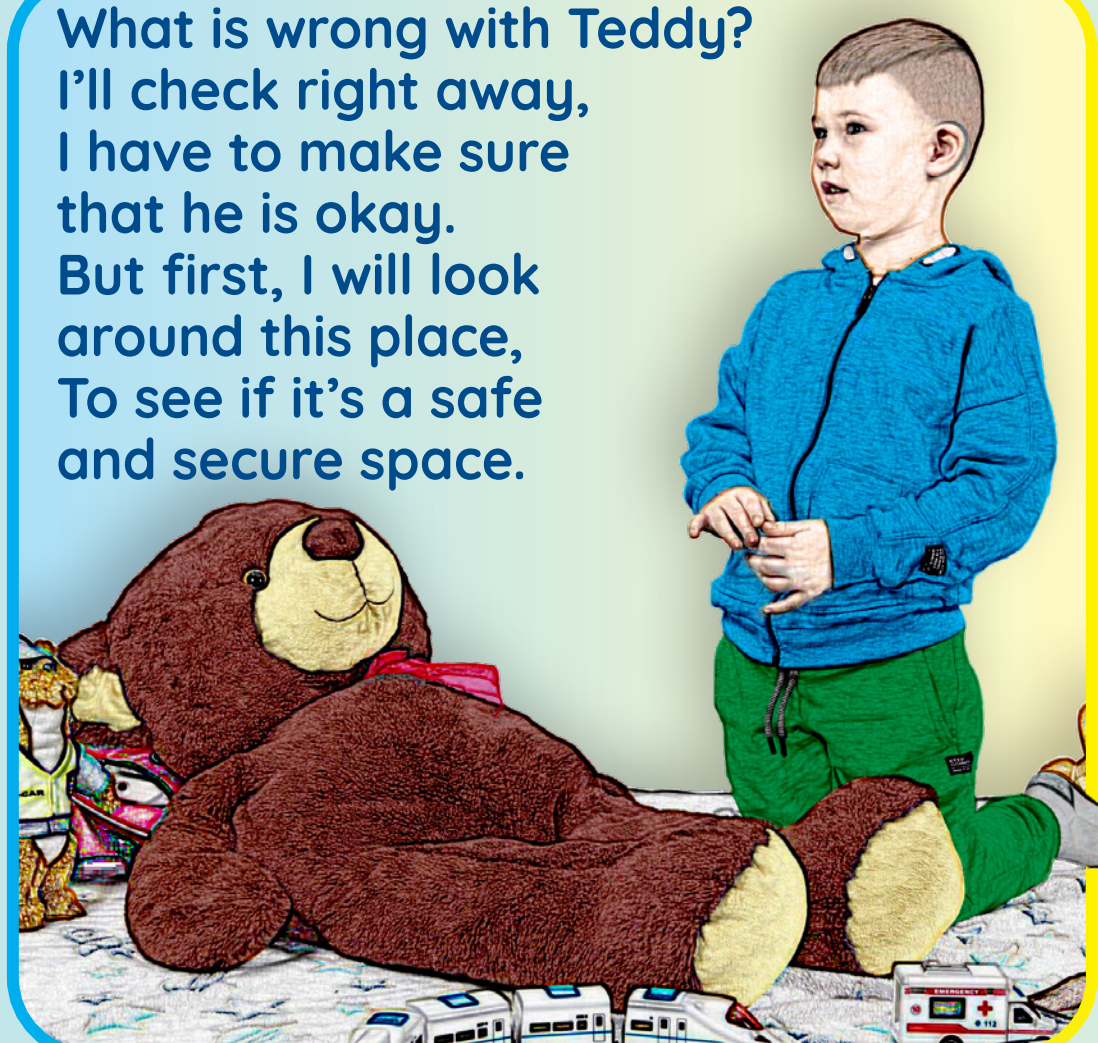
SAVING TEDDY TODAY

for you!

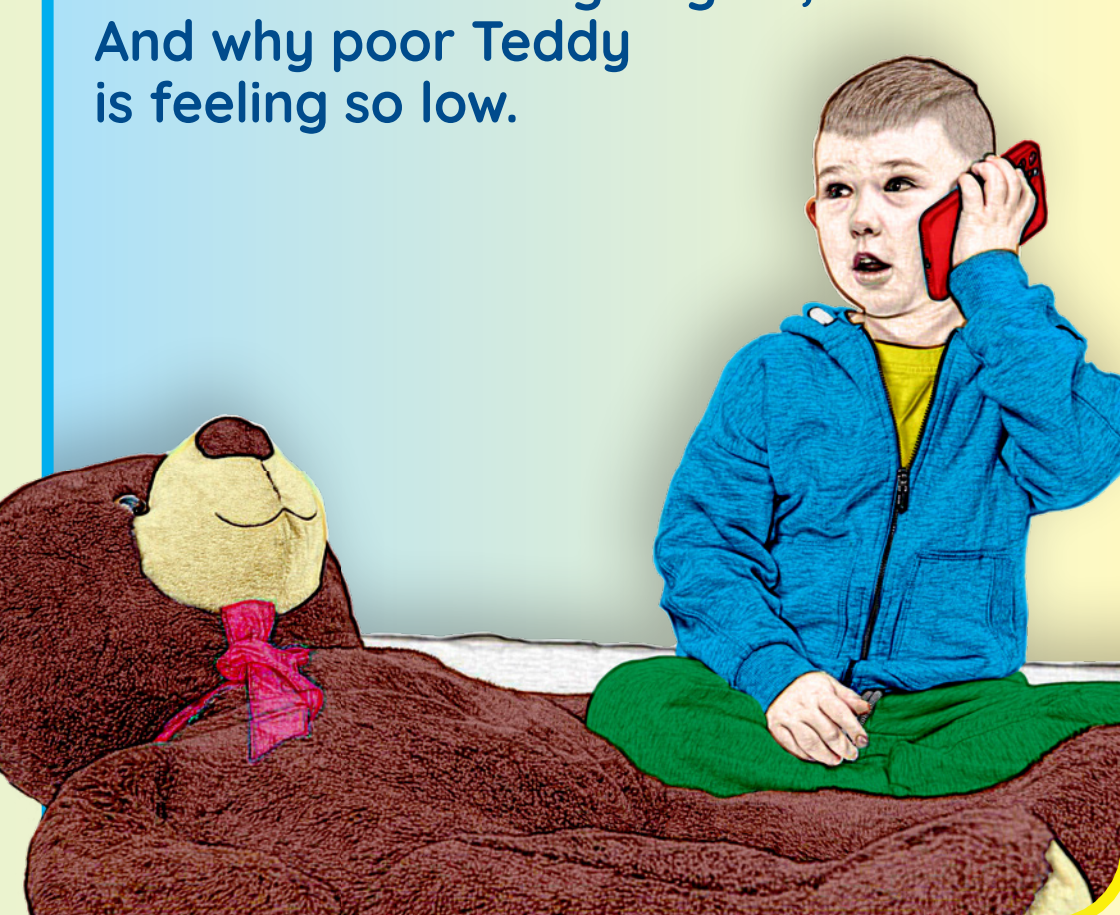

is feeling so low.



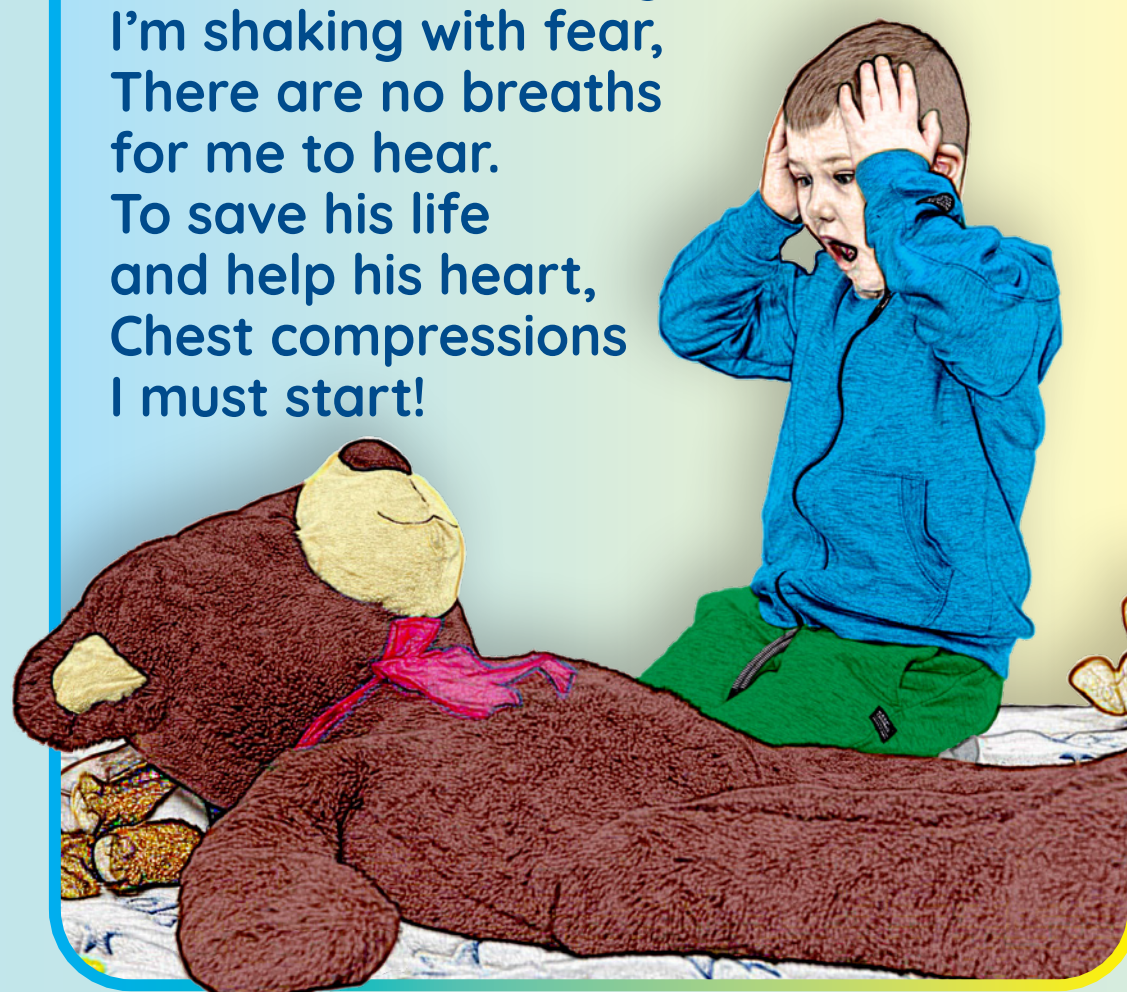
